DARE LTTA in Pisa, Italy

A Learning, Teaching, Training Activity (LTTA), within the structure of strategic partnerships, aims to contribute to the capacity building of working teams of the partner organizations in order to maximise their learning impact and better prepare the youth workers and staff members of the partner organisations for the development of the intellectual outputs.

The DARE LTTA took place in beautiful Pisa, on November $11^{th}-17^{th}$ 2019 and was hosted by our Italian partner Aforisma.

In total, 18 participants took part in the DARE LTTA. Among them there were representatives of the 5 project partners as well as youth workers and young people that cooperate with the partner organisations. Some of the participants represented the target group of DARE project, which is young people with physical, visual and hearing impairments.

Each partner was responsible for one day of the activity to prepare the sessions, info material and methods according to its field of expertise.

1st day: Aforisma initiated a process for the participants to get to know each other better.

2nd day: Kainotomia offered intense and inspiring exercises to raise awareness for the different types of impairments/disabilities. Starting from this point participants went deeper into the meaning of inclusion and managed finally to bridge inclusion with the international youth mobilities.

3rd day: Kreisau-Initiative e.V. introduced the inclusive design of activities/methods and participants worked on transforming activities into inclusive ones and they reflected on this process as a team.

4th day: Jugend- & Kulturprojekt e.V. presented the theoretical background of non-formal education and put a spotlight on the European Solidarity Corps Initiative which creates opportunities for young people to volunteer or work in projects in their own country or abroad that benefit communities and people around Europe.

5th day: Danmar Computers was responsible for the last day which was dedicated to the topic of accessibility. This session gave a lot of space to the participants with impairments to share their insights and valuable experiences.

Summing up, the diversity in our group and the various backgrounds of the participants made this LTTA an instructive and valuable experience for all!







3rd Transnational Project Meeting in Poland
